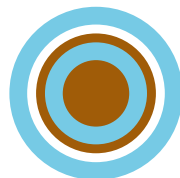
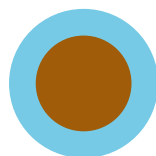
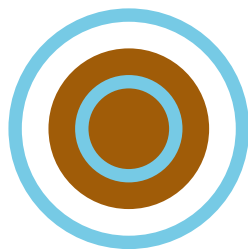


The Workforce Unit...

The Voluntary Sector Social Services Workforce Unit aims to support and promote the development of the sector's workforce in Scotland.

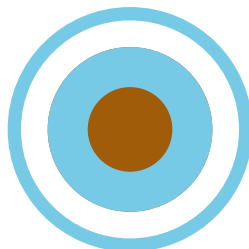

Recognising potential...

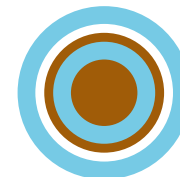
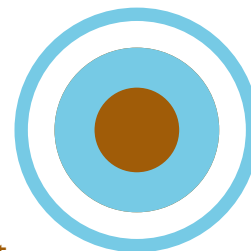

- Collaborative and cross-sector working



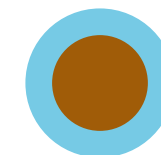
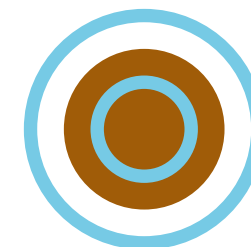
