- Funding Deadlines:

Period (2022-23)	Deadline
<b>Quarter 1</b> 1 April 2022 to 30 June 2022 (inclusive)	Claims are to be submitted to IA/LA by <b>14 October 2022</b> .
<b>Quarter 2</b> 1 July 2022 to 30 September 2022 (inclusive)	<b>Either</b> (i) Claims are to be submitted to the IA/LA by <b>14 October 2022</b> <b>or</b> (ii) a notice of the intent to submit a claim which includes an estimated claim value should be submitted to the IA/LA by <b>14 October 2022</b> . Where a notice of intent is used, this will be followed up by a claim to be submitted to the IA/LA by <b>30 November 2022</b> .
<b>Quarter 3</b> 1 October 2022 to 31 December 2022 (inclusive)	Claims are to be submitted to the IA/LA by <b>28 February 2023</b> .
<b>Quarter 4</b> 1 January 2023 to 31 March 2023 (inclusive)	Claims are to be submitted to the IA/LA by <b>30 April 2023</b>

Please note: Any concerns with adhering to these deadlines should be raised and discussed with your IA/LA immediately.
